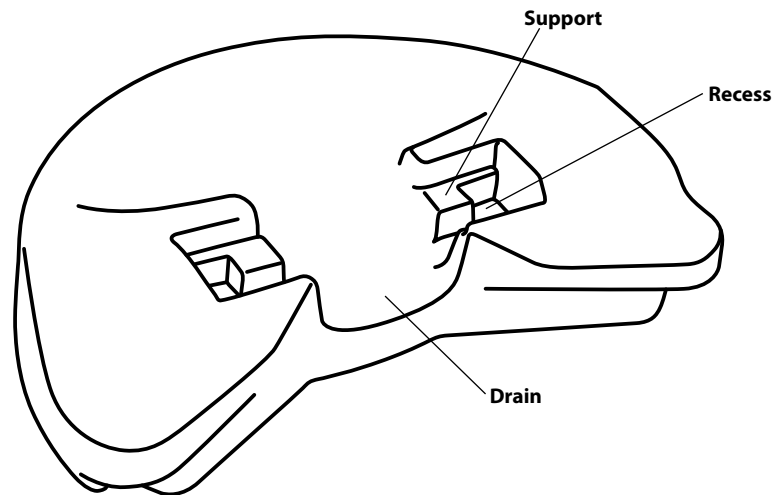


The Ultimate Uncapper™ USER GUIDE



- Place **Ultimate Uncapper™** on top of an empty 5 or 6 gallon bucket or bottling bucket, making sure it is fully seated on rim. If using bottling bucket make sure the honey gate is closed.
- If using bucket strainer or filter bag place these on bucket before installing **Ultimate Uncapper™**.
- Place frame, medium or shallow, short side down, in support tray with frame ear in recess. The side will sit on supports.
- Frame can be tilted back on supports to hold upright*.
- Always hold top of frame securely, usually by the frame ear, when cutting cappings and watch knife carefully to avoid cuts.
- Cappings can be removed with a hot or cold knife as well as an uncapper fork.
- When cutting keep strokes short to prevent cappings and drippings from falling over edge of uncapper.
- To switch sides lift frame and rotate so frame ear sits in opposite recess.
- If cutting from the top down tip the frame forward for best results since the cappings will fall away and into the front of the bucket.
- If cutting from the bottom up tip the frame back to get the knife started and then tip forward so that the cappings pull away and fall into the front of the bucket.
- **Ultimate Uncapper™** is designed to eliminate drips by catching drippings from the frame ear and directing them into the bucket.
- To clean **Ultimate Uncapper™** let honey drip into tank and then wash with warm, soapy. Rinse under warm water and allow to dry.
- Store **Ultimate Uncapper™** in bucket for next use.

SAFETY HINTS

- Always clean Ultimate Bucket Uncapper™ with warm soapy water and rinse before and after each use as part of a safe food-handling program.
- Do not leave hot uncapping knife/plane on **Uncapper™**.

*Works with most square cornered ears and some rounded or beveled ears.
